This training is a 2-day program designed for Simiron Dealers only. *This class is not open to contractors.* The class will cover surface inspection, moisture detection methods, preparation techniques, patching and repair techniques, primer and epoxy installation methods, metallic application, decorative chip and non-skid application, clear coats and problem solving. *This is not a sample board class.* We will be working on concrete floors and walls.

## **Agenda:**

- Classroom: Overview of Simiron and our product lines
- Surface Inspection: Assessment of the concrete slab. Inspection of previous coatings. Contaminant inspection and removal
- Moisture Readings: Instruction on the 3 methods of moisture detection and the equipment used
- Preparation: Instruction on the methods of concrete slab prep for previously coated and uncoated surfaces. Contamination detection and removal
- Patching/Repair: Instruction on using epoxy patch material and other products commonly used in the field
- Primer & Epoxy: Mixing and application instruction using commonly used techniques
- Decorative Chip and Non-Skid: Application techniques and instruction
- Clear Coats: Application techniques and instruction
- Problem Solving: Understanding common field problems associated with floor coatings and repair methods: (outgassing, cratering, sticky spots, surface tension, amine blushing, etc.)
- Sample Making: Instruction on how to make sample boards for store and project use
